INTRODUCTION

We require the **on-site or teleradiology** participation of a trained and qualified, **California-licensed radiologist with pediatric experience and/or training**, to be part of a multidisciplinary team of pediatric bone pathology experts (including bone pathology, forensic pathology, forensic anthropology, skeletal radiology). The team participates in the primary evaluation, documentation and reporting of bone pathology specimens obtained during forensic autopsy. Radiologic studies to be considered in this context include antemortem and postmortem radiographs, Faxitron specimen radiographs, as well as antemortem and postmortem CT scans.

POSITION DESCRIPTION

This multi-faceted position requires exceptional analytical and collaborative skills, as well as the ability to handle sensitive and complex cases involving medical forensics. - Meet organizational metrics for analysis and reporting
- Serve as an educator for approved internal and extramural activities

- Successful completion of a recognized pediatric radiology fellowship program is preferred
